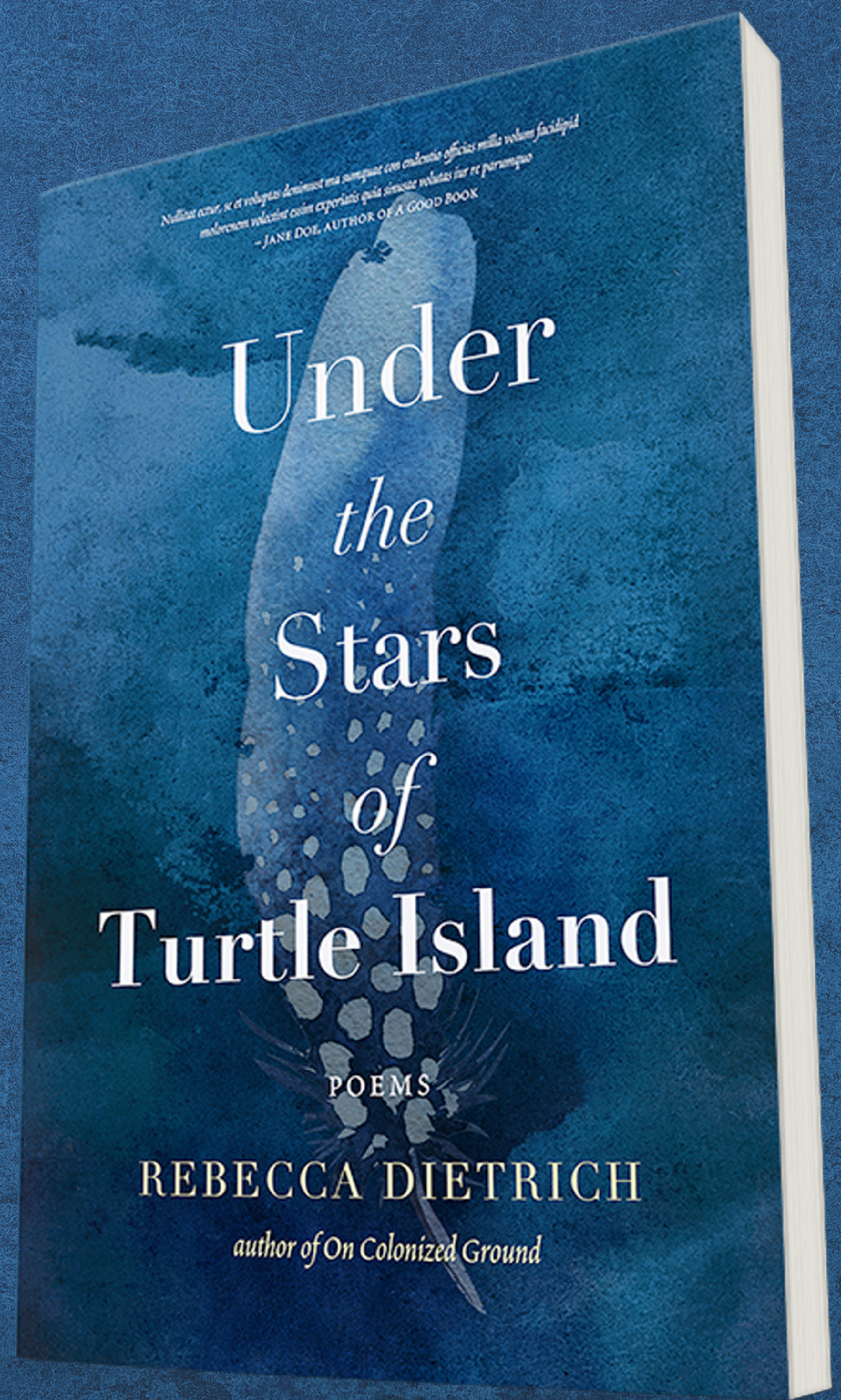


Under the Stars of Turtle Island
